FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS

Attorney's Report – Ms. Whelan presented two additional items for the Board's consideration. The Funding Agreement between the District and Country Club East Investors, LLC is in the standard developer funding agreement form. Ms. Whelan asked for public comments and hearing none asked for a motion to approve.

Mr. Perka provided details noting that Country Club East is being developed in phases; in a prior plat the easterly portion of the lake was conveyed to the District, the westerly portion of the pond is for the most part completed but there may be some additional modifications to the exact boundaries of the pond in the future. At this time the District will be granted an easement to maintain the entire pond until such time when the pond perimeter is permanently defined and fully conveyed to the District. Mr. Perka noted for the record that the landowner entity is Lakewood Ranch Golf Company. Mr. Jensen asked for public comments and hearing none asked for a motion to approve in substantial form.
