Engineer's Report – Mr. Kennedy noted that the initial intent was to have one overall developer agreement for infrastructure for water, wastewater, and the reclaimed lines for the Lakewood Ranch Southeast Development, however, a timing issue has come up with Toll Brothers. They have started building homes and are about 60-90 days out before being ready to close on those homes with end users. Through a previous agreement with the County, Toll Brothers were required to put in water treatment facilities. Staff met with the County and an agreement was reached that allows the District to move forward with an Interlocal Agreement between the District and the County for the water facilities only. Mr. Johnson noted that Staff expect to present a draft of the agreement to the County next week and asked that authority be delegated to the Chair in case the agreement needed to be signed prior to the next meeting in order to be included on the County's agenda and for the County to complete the execution of the agreement. The final document will be brought back to the Board for ratification. Mr. Johnson confirmed that the agreement does not obligate the District to pay an amount by a certain date.

On MOTION by Mr. Chiofalo, seconded by Mr. Gleeson, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors of the Lakewood Ranch Stewardship District approved delegating authority to the Chairman to execute the Interlocal Agreement.
